Forty five years ago, Herb Blitzer started his career in photography and imaging by taking a position as a photographic engineer with the Eastman Kodak Company. During the next 33 ½ years, he held positions in research, development, manufacturing, strategic planning and marketing. He provided advisory support to the City of Indianapolis, helping the police department move up to new digital technology. The awareness of the need for extending digital technology to legal pursuits led him to create the Institute for Forensic Imaging, where he is now executive director.

The Institute conducts research, provides training and engages in consulting. Blitzer has been principal investigator on several grant-funded projects, has written several articles, presented many papers, and developed testing methods and processes for evaluating video systems for use in police cars. He has been an expert witness and teaches as a visiting professor of physics and forensic science at Indiana University Purdue University Indianapolis, in the school of science.
